Jamestown Settlement

Virginia has long been recognized as the birthplace of America and 2019 is the 400th anniversary of four events of national significance. Throughout 2019 Virginia is commemorating the 400th anniversary of the first representative legislative assembly in the New World, the recruitment of English women in significant numbers, the arrival of the first Africans to English North America, and the observance of the first official English Thanksgiving in North America.

In honor of the arrival of the Brideship in 1619, a special exhibit, **Tenacity: Women of Jamestown and Early Virginia**, is on view at Jamestown Settlement. We will visit the indoor exhibits at our own pace when we arrive. At 11 a.m., we will have a guided tour of the outdoor replicas of the Indian Village, the three ships, and the village of Jamestown.



Lunch will be on your own at Center Street Grill. We will order off the menu and pay with separate checks. You can look up the menu online in advance: www.centerstreetgrill.com.



Tour of the Virginia Beer Company Brewery and Optional Beer Tasting

Since clean drinking water was in short supply in the 17th century, the beverage of choice was beer for children as well as adults. It did have much lower alcohol content, however. We will continue our re-discovery of our fore-fathers' and -mothers' lifestyle with a visit to the Virginia Beer Company, where we will have a tour and optional tasting. The Virginia Beer Company suggests a variety of ways to sample their beer choices. The prices range between \$2 and \$8. Purchasing beer samples is on your own.



The cost of \$95 for members and \$99 for non-members includes transportation in a 38-passenger bus, tip for the bus driver, and entry fee to the Jamestown Settlement. The cost is based on a minimal participation of 15 people. Lunch will be on your own. Cancellation with full refund must be received by the treasurer in writing before the deadline for payment (**October 4, 2019**). Substitutes are allowed.
